We've Come a Long Way

Maryland Cave Survey trips in the late 60's would often include a jog over the state line to West Virginia. The drinking age was 18 and the beer was cheap, fine with us even at 3.2%. Years later, we'd stop at the Eagles in Davis or the Moose in Franklin for icy Iron City or Stroh's, but mostly we imported our own real beer by the case. It's different now. In 1994 Cardinal Brewing Company made the first non-brewpub craft brew in the state, and in 2009 when the 6% limit was raised to 12% the craft beer revolution took off. In 2019 it was raised to 15%.

OTR has a rich beer history. "Free" taps have been flowing since the 3.2 days, and in the '90s West Virginia Brewing Company attempted the miracle of unlimited micro-brew for only \$10. Amazed at cavers' thirst, Doug from Morgantown had to rethink his business plan. After trying four different ways to sell unlimited brew, he gave up and offered a punch card. In 1998 Kelley, Shack, and Ray tried selling Guinness across the lane from the free taps at the pavilion. They believed that "the caver with a sophisticated palate" would enjoy high-grade brew offered at a modest cost. Ray says that they considered Coots' Bar but settled on the "more classy" COOTERS. Brilliant! Featuring first class facilities and primo entertainment, COOTERS is now a tradition and a COOT in its own right. That said, free beer is hard to beat and naked beer runs still patronize the brew crew. Cold. Wet. Beer. The stuff of dreams.

Did you know...

Did you know that during the years of prohibition, physicians could write prescriptions for "Medicinal Spirits"?

In the spirit of reliving those years, Doktor Steve will offer almost free examinations. After a thorough evaluation and if your condition meets established criteria, attendees MIGHT be able to receive a "prescription" for Medicinal Spirits.
