First Aid volunteers are also available to provide support and shelter. Both the Security Office and the First Aid station are staffed around the clock and staff are prepared to provide a safe space. There are a lot of resources available on site at all hours. You are never alone or unprotected.

Let us be very clear: If you are reporting a problem concerning yourself or another, we do not care if you are drunk or altered in any other way. You will not be punished for coming to us with your concerns at any time.

We want OTR to be a safe and fun place for all, but we cannot do anything about bad actors if we don't know about them. It is our sincere goal and everyone's responsibility to make OTR a safe and fun place for ALL!



The Contest Connection by Sharon Brinkman-Windle

Each Speleo-Olympic contest relies on the expertise and commitment of experienced cavers. Here are some of our volunteers willing to be interviewed. Each was asked five questions: How long have you been caving? What is your primary grotto? How many OTRs have you attended? What is your favorite contest memory? Why do you volunteer?

Tom Griffin started his caving career in Trout Cave in 1969. He is a member of Seven Valleys Grotto and this will be his ROOT year, or 40th OTR. His favorite contest memories were competing as a family with his five kids, doing the obstacle

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course, and getting a certificate for a family group of competitors. "Volunteering is something I enjoy doing. I volunteered a lot when we first bought the property, but in recent years, it has been mainly the vertical contests." This year, Tom will be judging the cable ladder contest with his wife, Red Schock.

Clayton Lilly judges the Carbide Lamp Assembly contest. He has been caving for over 40 years and has attended 42 OTRs. He belongs to a caving group that is an offshoot of the original WVU Outing Club started by his parents in the 1970s. His favorite contest memory was watching his son get so excited about running the obstacle course. "Without volunteers keeping things afloat, we would lose important traditions. We need to preserve them. Where else would you assemble a carbide lamp blindfolded?"

There will be a new moon on Labor Day, which means that only starlight will be the illumination in the night sky during our OTR weekend. If it's clear, it will be great for star gazing. The Milky Way should be quite distinct. For safety, carry an extra light source with you so you can spot those evil tent stakes and lines and point out trippy spots. Mark danger zones in your campsite with dusk to dawn solar lights or chemical light sticks. The full Sturgeon Moon was at 2:26 p.m. on August 19th. The Harvest Moon is the full moon closest to the autumnal equinox. It occurs this year on September 17th at 10:34 p.m.
